RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Highway 17/417 corridor is a vital economic link for the County of Renfrew, providing for the transportation of goods and services to interprovincial and international destinations, as well as tangible benefits to our tourism and recreation industries; and

WHEREAS the Highway 17/417 network is an integral part of the TransCanada Highway and a Core Route in the National Highway network; and

WHEREAS Atomic Energy of Canada Limited and CFB Petawawa rely extensively on this highway network as well; and

WHEREAS the Province of Ontario has invested millions of dollars in the extension of Highway 417 from the west end of the City of Ottawa, up to and including the Town of Arnprior; and

WHEREAS the extension of Highway 417 currently is not included in the Province's five-year Southeastern Ontario Capital Program; and

WHEREAS the extension of Highway 417 to the Town of Renfrew would connect existing major highways, both in the Province of Ontario and the Province of Quebec; and

WHEREAS a priority should be given to extending Highway 417 to the Town of Renfrew and that this priority should be reflected in the Provincial five-year Southeastern Ontario Capital Program in order to optimize the Province's investment to date in Highway 417.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Province of Ontario be requested to designate the extension of Highway 417 from the Town of Arnprior to the Town of Renfrew as a priority project and that it be reflected in the Province's five-year Southeastern Region Capital Program.
