

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RENFREW
BY-LAW NO. 41-2007

Being a By-law to regulate the use of basketball
nets on municipal road allowances within the Town
of Renfrew.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew is desirous to pass a
by-law to regulate the use of basketball nets on municipal road allowances; and


WHEREAS the Council of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew deems
it to be in the public interest to set policy to provide guidelines for the use of basketball
nets on municipal road allowances.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew enacts as
follows:


1. a) THAT basketball nets must not be located on the traveled portion of the road
or sidewalk, even temporarily.
 - b) THAT when basketball nets are in use, they can be located on the road
allowance provided the nets are facing the driveway and are positioned to
discourage play on the streets.
 - c) THAT basketball nets, when not in use for extended periods (ie. off-season
months), must be moved off of the road allowance.
 - d) THAT permanent basketball net installations are prohibited on municipal road
allowances.
 - e) THAT basketball net installations found to be in contravention to this by-law will
be relocated by town staff at the residents expense.
2. THAT in the event that town staff are required to reposition a basketball net
installation, all costs associated with respect to labour and equipment will be
invoiced to the resident.
 3. THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the
passage thereof.

Read a third time and finally passed this 30th day of July, 2007
