

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RENFREW
BY-LAW NO. 34-2016

Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute an Extension Agreement with Beauman Waste Management Systems Ltd. for the provision of recycling collection services from September 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017.

WHEREAS Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, empowers the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew to pass by-laws and to enter into agreements respecting matters within the waste management sphere of jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew deems it advisable and in the public interest to enter into an Extension Agreement with Beauman Waste Management Systems Ltd. for the provision of recycling collection services.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew enacts as follows:

- 1) THAT the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized, on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew, to execute an agreement to extend recycling collection services with Beauman Waste Management from September 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017, based on the original terms of the present contract.
- 2) THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passage thereof.

Read a first and second time this 24th day of May, 2016.

Read a third and final time this 24th day of May, 2016.

Beaumen News and Recycling Market Update


As of September 1, 2016 the curbside recycling pickup will no longer accept any Styrofoam of any kind and no loose plastic bags of any kind. The only exception will be a bag of bags (all grocery bags and loose plastic in one bag).

This change in processing policy for Styrofoam is due to market changes beyond our control. We have been unable to find a buyer of Styrofoam during the last two years. Traditionally, it was processed in Canada or China. Neither of these jurisdictions will accept nor purchase any Styrofoam.

We have retooled our recycling processing plant to keep efficiency high and our processing costs low over the past year. Loose plastic and plastic bags cannot be processed by our automated system; a bag of bags is acceptable as it can be manually picked out during our pre-sort.
