Beginning in July 2018, the Town of Renfrew commenced the design for Stewart Street (Highway 60).

Project Description

The existing street infrastructure has reached the end of its life-cycle, and the Town has identified the need for reconstruction. The Stewart Street reconstruction project has been broken into two parts.

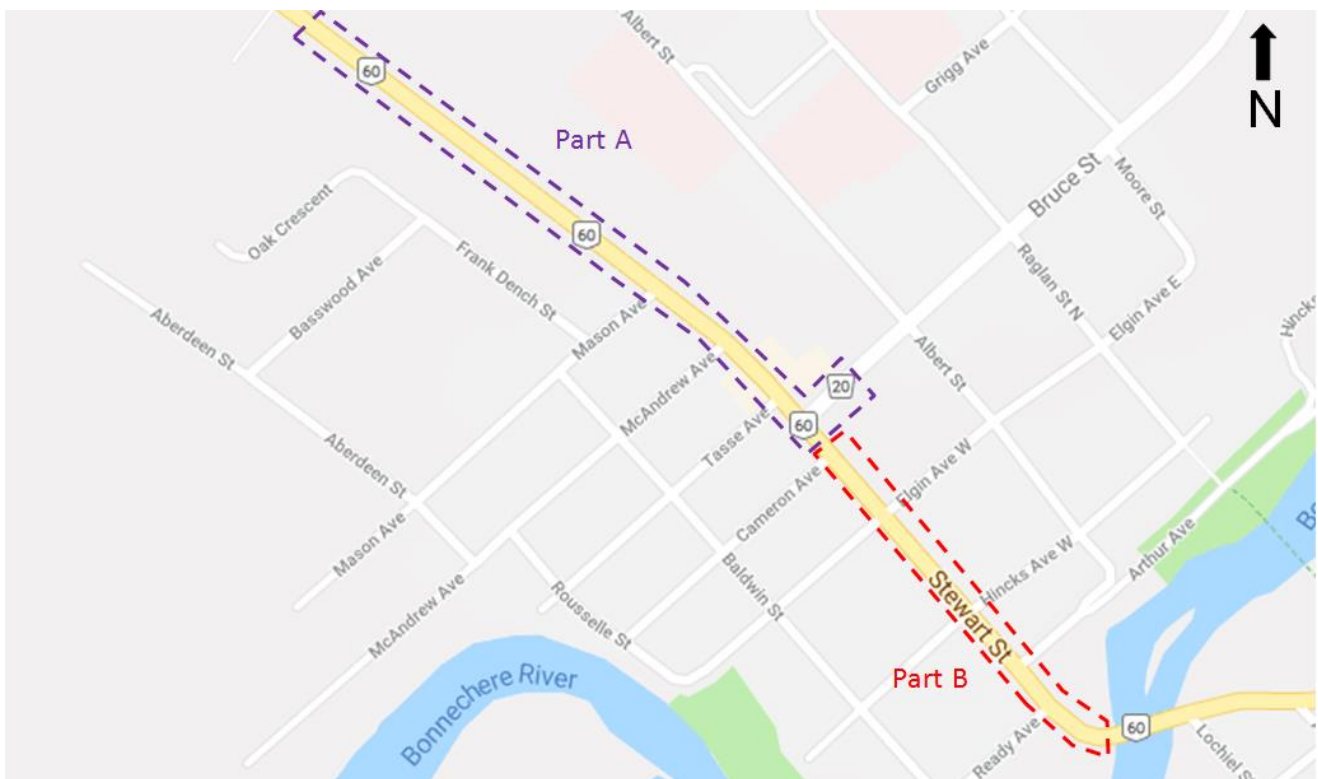
Part 'A' - Stewart Street from Town limits to Bruce Street (County Road 20) including the intersection.

Part 'B' - Stewart Street from Bruce Street (County Road 20) to the Bonnechere River Bridge.

The construction work will renew infrastructure in your neighborhood. Specifically, the works proposed include the introduction, rehabilitation and/or replacement of:

- Watermain extension/ replacement
- Sanitary sewer extension/ replacement
- Lateral services to the property line/buildings as required
- Road structure and pavement
- Creation of a multi-use pathway
- Curbs
- Sidewalks
- Traffic control signal system
- Landscaping
- Utility reconstruction as required
- Street lighting and signage as funds permit.

Project Result and Timing

The design for the project is anticipated to be completed by March 31, 2019. The construction is planned to begin in the spring of 2019 and completed in the fall of 2019 subject to funding.

Funding

The project design for part 'A' is being completed with financial contributions from the Ministry of Transportation's Connecting Links Program Intake 3 (2018-19) and the Town of Renfrew. Part B design is being funded solely by the Town of Renfrew.

Currently, the Town of Renfrew has no funding for the construction as the Ministry of Transportation's Connecting Links Program Intake 4 was not released in the fall of 2018.
