



# Town of Renfrew Garbage and Recycling Information

As of September 1, 2011 Canadian Waste Management will be providing the curbside garbage collection and Beaumen Waste Management will still be providing recycling collection.

## **Garbage Collection:**

Garbage collection will occur once a week.

There is a limit of 3 bags per residential stop and a limit of 6 bags per commercial stop. Each garbage container shall not have a volume exceeding 0.2 m<sup>3</sup> (4ft<sup>3</sup>) and when filled does not weigh more than 23kg (50lb).

## **Recycling Collection:**

Recycling collection will occur once every second week and weekly for downtown core.

There is no limit for residential, and a limit of eight (8) blue boxes and two (2) clear plastic bags of fine paper per stop will be placed on industrial, commercial and institutional recyclers. Recycling containers shall not be larger than 15" by 18" by 22" in size.

NOTE: Consult the attached schedule and map to verify the day of your garbage and recycling pickup. All garbage and recycling should be at the end of your driveway by 7 am to ensure pickup.

## **Landfill Site:**

**Open:** Tuesday to Saturday: 8:00am to 4:00pm.

**Closed:** Sundays, Mondays and all statutory holidays.

## **Tires**

All Tires disposed at Landfill are subject to a fee. Tires without rims may be disposed at local tire shops at no charge.

**NOTE:** Appliances (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc) all carry a \$16.00 refrigerant removal fee if not accompanied by an ODP (ozone depletion prevention) sticker.

Cardboard, Scrap Metal, and all Recyclables must be disposed of in their designated areas. Facilities for cardboard and scrap metal recycling are provided at the landfill site.

## **Household Hazardous Waste Depot:**

The Household Hazardous Waste Depot is a free service provided to you and it is located at the landfill site from spring to fall (see schedule).

At the Depot, you can dispose of the following substances: Paint, Solvents, Turpentine, Disinfectants, Propane Tanks, Household Cleaners, Herbicides and Pesticides, Batteries (home and Car), Pool Chemicals, Varnish, Anti-freeze, Bleach, Furniture Strippers, Drain and Oven cleaner, Brake fluid, Used Oil and Filters.

## **Electronic Waste:**

This free service allows the following items to be disposed of at the landfill site all year round:

Desktop computers, laptop computers, keyboards, computer mouse, computer printers, monitors, disk drives, fax machines, televisions, phones (land line and cell), VCR and DVD players, Stereos, PDA's, cameras and photocopiers.

## **Yard and Leaf Waste:**

Renfrew residents may dispose of their leaves/grass free of charge at the Landfill Site at any time during hours of operation. All bags/containers must be emptied at the designated area and the bags must be free of paper and other refuse when emptied at the designated area. Additionally curbside collection will occur 6 weeks throughout the year (see schedule) All waste collected must be in paper bags or bound bundles and must be in a separate area from garbage. Branches must not exceed 25 mm (1 Inch) in diameter.

## Town of Renfrew Recycling Program

The recycling program is a two stream system. Both streams will be picked up on the same day. Do not mix your fiber material waste with your regular blue box waste.

### Stream 1: Fiber

Place all of the following in a blue box or in your largest cardboard box and place at the curbside for removal.

- Newsprint
- Boxboard & paperboard
- Magazines and telephone directories
- Envelopes, flyers and junk mail
- Fine paper including writing and computer paper
- Brown paper bags
- Plain wrapping paper and tissue paper, including Christmas wrapping paper
- Greeting cards
- Paper cups and plates
- Polycoat paperboards, i.e. ice cream, freezer food
- Corrugated cardboard



### Stream 2: All Other

The following is a list of items that can now be placed at the curbside for recycling.

#### Metals:

- Aluminum food and beverage containers
- Steel food and beverage containers
- Aluminum foil and foil containers
- EMPTY, dry paint cans with lids removed
- EMPTY aerosol cans (such as hairspray and spray paint) all types

#### Plastics:

- Plastics number 1-7



- Plastic tubs and lids
- Plastic Film (including grocery bags, bread bags)

#### Cartons:

- Milk and juice cartons
- Tetra packs (including drinking boxes)

#### Clear/ Coloured Glass:

- Glass bottles and jars for food and beverage

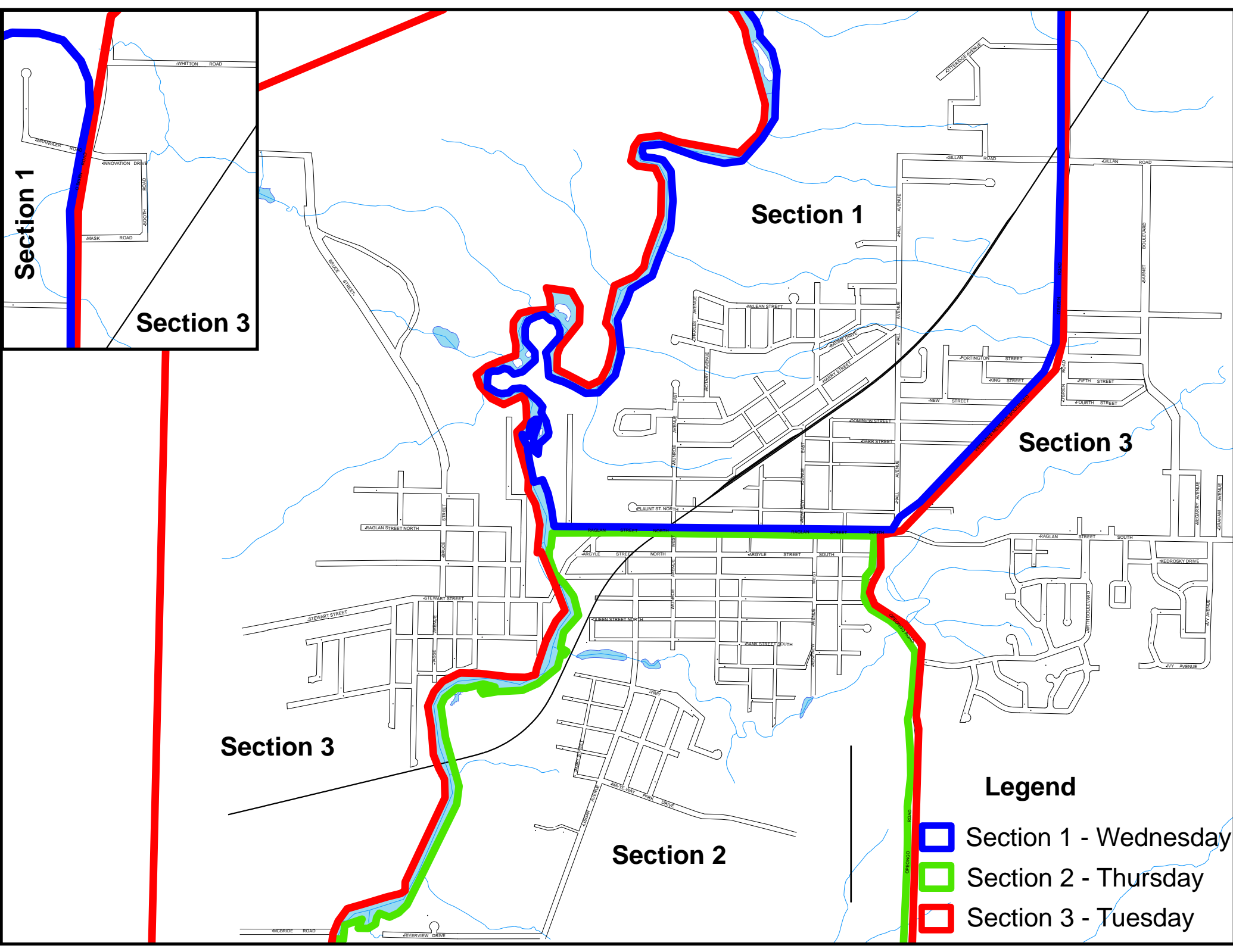

**Yard and Leaf Waste Curbside Collection:** During the weeks commencing on April 16<sup>th</sup>, April 30<sup>th</sup>, and May 14<sup>th</sup> during the spring and during the weeks commencing on October 15<sup>th</sup>, October 29<sup>th</sup>, and November 12<sup>th</sup> in the fall. Yard waste will be picked up any day of that week excluding Monday.
